Course Objectives

This year's tutorial aims to provide an update in various areas of Haematopathology as chosen by our guest tutors. Topics to be addressed include:

- T-cell and NK-cell lymphomas and lymphoproliferations
- Cutaneous lymphomas and lymphoproliferations of T-cell and NK-cell type
- Benign tumour like lesions with B- and T-cell predominance
- EBV-associated B-cell proliferations

The course is case based. Scanned slides from approximately 40 challenging and instructive cases will be available for delegates to view prior to the meeting. The cases will be presented and discussed during the meeting by our group of internationally renowned tutors. To facilitate discussion, tutors will provide an overview of the areas covered, with emphasis on recent diagnostic advances. Audience participation is strongly encouraged to create a relaxed and enjoyable learning environment. At the conclusion of the course, participants will have been updated on a broad range of problem areas pertinent to lymphoma diagnosis and be equipped with a practical approach to resolving difficult diagnostic dilemmas as they are encountered in routine practice. The course is suited to practising Haematopathologists, as well as Pathologists with an interest in Haematopathology or lymphoma diagnosis, and Pathologists in training.
